The Project:

- a) The donor is Fondation Eagle.
- b) The project's title is "A new ambulance".
- c) Foundation Eagle reference number was FF 682, now changed to FF682a.
- d) Date of grant accepted was 27th September 2023.
- e) The amount was £29,412 for a new ambulance.
- f) The number of beneficiaries for the Children's Mobile Clinic's new ambulance is 25,000.
- g) The location is Nkhotakota district and its environs:
- h) Period of Project is from 1st October 2023 to 30th September 2024.
- i) The exchange rate £UK/Mk in October 2023 was £1 = 1,320Mk; the unexpected November devaluation of the kwacha by 40% and other factors has led to a 63% drop in value of the kwacha to a rate today of £1 = 2,150Mk.

Summary:

The actual cost of the vehicle and its transportation to Malawi rose by £530 against our estimates because of the movement in the exchange rate of £UK against the Japanese Yen. This was balanced by a decrease in the Clearing Agent costs in Lilongwe of £475, leaving an overall overspend of £55.



Our New Ambulance:

If medicines are the life blood of our projects, the trusty 4 x 4 vehicle that carries our clinical team can go anywhere, is its heart.

Four-wheel-drive ambulances play a vital role in providing medical assistance to those living in areas not normally accessible by normal city-bound ambulances. The Land Cruiser Hardtop Ambulance provide a real lifeline to those working in rural communities in need of urgent medical attention.

At virtually every mobile clinic there will be children who require emergency surgery or in-patient care - and it is our trusty ambulance that will carry them into hospital for life-saving care.

Our vehicles are precious to us, so we ensure they are scrupulously serviced on schedule by the Toyota main dealership in Lilongwe and we employ drivers who know how to care for their vehicles.

The challenge is the desperately rough terrain we must cross to reach our clinic sites; it takes a savage toll on suspension and steering joints and components.

The vehicle easily converts from ambulance to 12 person carrier, which is often the most practical setup for our mobile clinics.

The journey:

Having been approved as an international NGO by Toyota we can purchase our vehicles from Toyota Gibraltar Stockholdings; they are official supplier of Toyota vehicles for NGOs and offer the keenest prices.

Our new ambulance was intended to travel from Gibraltar to Dar es Salam by sea through the Suez Canal but this was delayed by the Yemen's Houthi rebels attacking ships in the Gulf of Aden.

This meant the ship carrying our ambulance had to take the long Atlantic route around West Africa and Cape Town, a journey of 7,446 nautical miles taking around a month. It finally safely arrived in Dar es Salam and following the relevant clearances was loaded in its container for the 1,500km final stage of its journey to Lilongwe container port.

With the delays in the delivery of the vehicle we were grateful to the Irish Embassy in Lilongwe who having heard of our problem passed on one of the embassies old vehicles, a 2009 Toyota Prado to help us run the second mobile clinic.

The new vehicle, although the same model is a vast step forward from the previous seven-year-old one – that one was ideal for the job but it always felt like it was a vehicle designed for rough terrain rather than a long drive on tarmac roads.

I (MB) took the opportunity to test drive the new vehicle to one clinic and it is comfortable, quieter and quite pleasant to drive; almost like a Prado.

The vehicle is fitted with a range of extras to qualify as an ambulance including the flashing lights and siren.

Tracking systems:

There is misuse of vehicles in Africa; to ensure ours are treated with respect we have tracking systems in each one and our drivers are aware of this. This gives us minute detail of every trip and how the vehicles are being driven. In previous vehicles the cost was around £500 per year because of limited cell phone coverage meaning it also needed a satellite phone facility for universal coverage – today with widespread cell phone coverage that is no longer necessary, and the costs are now down to less than half.

Overland:

After its laborious voyage around Africa the container finally arrived at Dar es Salam. We were concerned that the overland journey would be "At Shippers risk" but Toyota explained it was fully insured and all risks were covered.

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

We feel sorry for the families who live along this road; the dust must make it an extremely unhealthy environment.


Lilongwe:

We work in the villages away from the tarmac roads because that is where the need for our medical skills and medicines is by far the greatest. That means much of its working life will be traversing rough terrain, severely testing the suspension and steering components.

This a really tough working environment so our protocol is to maintain a strict servicing schedule with checks at the main Toyota dealer at 5,000km intervals.
