- Last year we had included food production beneficiaries in the Food/Feeding category; the number of beneficiaries for this subcategory was: 5'666. Now that we have fully included this new category as "Food production". The 5'666 beneficiaries will be transferred from feeding to food production.
- Please note that most of the projects funded are construction and purchase of equipment, and thus the beneficiaries will be on-going for several years. In the table above only 1 year's beneficiaries are counted. The norm on average is 7-10 years' use for constructions in under-developed countries and 5-7 for equipment.
- The number of beneficiaries mentioned is the estimate made by the charities at the time of their request for funding. The actual number, reported on completion of the project may differ slightly from their first estimate.
