Background:

We need 3 things to perform our flagship children's mobile clinic programme that has treated over a third of a million children and saved so many young lives over the last fifteen years.

We need Medicine, Clinicians and a trustworthy Vehicle capable of delivering our team to the most remote villages over the most challenging terrain.

Vehicles are our life blood; we treat them with great care, ensuring they are perfectly maintained and serviced at the manufacturers recommended intervals.

Expected lifespan of vehicles where we operate is very low but by taking great care we achieve on average an eight year working life with well over 400,000km travelled.

It is well-known that misuse of vehicles in sub Saharan Africa is rife, the roads are typically in a very poor state of repair and driving is dangerous, especially at night.

This makes it difficult to raise funds for new vehicles and it is specifically excluded by many donors.

This is why we are deeply grateful to Fondation Eagle for supporting us in our time of need.

It has 13 seats making it the ideal vehicle to carry:-

2 Clinical Officers.

1 or 2 Nurses.

1 Driver/Medical Assistant.

1 Pharmacy technician.

5 Junior doctors/Final year medical students.

With space to carry back critically ill children for in-patient care.

Medicines, scales, diagnostic tools in a secure storage container on the Heavy-Duty roof rack.

- It will be the everyday working tool for our Children's Mobile Clinic programme that treats over 40,000 sick children every year.
 - We will take great care of this beautiful vehicle, all servicing will be done on time and replacements of key components such as tyres done in good time
 - Our drivers have been carefully chosen, are of the highest calibre and drive in a safe and responsible manner.
 - It will be stored in our heavily protected secure area inside our secure compound. We employ 6 security guards to ensure the safety of our staff, volunteer doctors and capital assets every night.
 - There can be no unauthorised misuse of the vehicle as it is fitted with the most sophisticated tracking system and all movements constantly displayed in great detail on our computers in the U.K.
 - Maximum speeds and accurate data on wherever the vehicle stops and how long for are recorded for all journeys.
 - Any vehicle usage outside our normal operating hours will immediately ring an alarm on our UK smart phones.



Costs:-

The donation we received from Fondation Eagle was for £34,691.00 The final cost was dependent on the £UK/JPN Yen exchange rate on the day and as the JPN Yen had eased slightly the actual amount we paid was £34,123.72.

In Malawi the vehicle entered free of duty; handling fees at Lilongwe container were and the costs of fitting the roof rack added £590 making the total expenditure £34,713.72

The WMF Mobile Clinics:

Since 2003 our children's clinics have served the remote poor in the villages of Nkhotakota in Malawi. The demand has increased year on year, proportionate with the failings of other health care providers.

Our estimate for 2018 is that 45,000 sick children will come to us for help; on our most recent clinic on Friday 20th April, our clinical team made up of two clinical officers, two nurses and eight final year medical students treated 392¹ sick children. See the montage from our Malawi team.
