Remarks

After the first measurments made in April 2017 (until mid of May for the government school's puplis, due to their late admissions), all together 219 children from the government school were concerned with the nutrition program

As we give the nutrition program to the Montessori children too, it is all together 259 children who are

concerned. The Montessori children don't appear in this BMI calculation. They are all receiving a snack 5 days a week.

We could notice that in the government school, 89 children were in mild underweight class and 82 pupils

Unfortunately, still 48 students of all government classes are severely underweight class.

All together, we observed that arouant 22% of the measurded children (with severe underweight) urgently need a better nutrition, which is our motivation to go on with this programme.

Mostly, the children who are not coming at school regularly are either staying at home or helping their parents in the fields works.

After the measurment in November, we were very happy that already 45 children could get a normal BMI and that only 8 remained in the Severe underweight position.

Remarks

On March 2018, only 211 children could be measured, as 8 of them left the school during the scholar's year.

Unfortunately, among them 2 girls from class 8 were married and are nowadays at their husbands' houses. Two others are staying at home and helping their parents on the fields.

Two pupils went to another school, one left to go to Kathmandu, two are helping their parents on the fields and one boy went to the next town and got an apprenticeship in a garage.

47 girls and 17 boys have improved their BMI and nowaday they are good health. 98 children have improved from under weight to mild under weight.

Delayed budgets and actual expenditure comparison

After the measurment of the students in May 2017, we decided to give the litho (special meal) not only to the pupils who were in severe or underweigth, but also for those who were in light underweigth.

We could immediately see that this was a very good idea, as the children improved within only 6 months.

In 2018-2019, we shall give the litho to everyone, every day.

The difference of CHF, 1'609.20 for the year of 2017-2018 will be assumed from the Association Ganesha Suisse-Népal, as it was a decision of its President.

Achievments

Every year we can notice that quite all children improve their BMI and consequently their health.

It is our pride to offer this nutrition programme, more over this last year, as we gave the litho programme to everyone and saw very good results.

Challenges

- 1, That every pupils, who needs to follow the nutrition programme, comes EVERY day to school! Unfortunately, it is not the case.
- 2. That the education of the parents, about nutrition for their children, can be followed with some results

Changes & differences:

Year after year, too many children get their enrollment in our school, so we don't really see changes in the frequenting of our school. So that every year, we have new cases. Anyway we are very optimistics and we see real progress for the pupils, more over after we change it and adapted it.

We are very happy about our nutrition programme and we want to go on with it as we notice, year after year, that the results are very good.







At the Montessori school, children are teached to plant different seeds: flowers are cultivated, as well as rice, potatoes, oinions, garlic, spinat, etc. We also planted some fruits trees like coconut trees, mangoes, papayas.

When products are ready, the children collect them and they eat them with great pleasure $\ensuremath{\omega}$

In the winter time, we often prepare the snack time outside, in the sun, to get also vitamines !
