Notes to the tables:

1) Please note that most of the projects are funds for construction and purchase of equipment, and thus the beneficiaries will be on-going for several years. I have only included the beneficiaries for 1 year in the table. On average we count 7-10 years for construction in under-developed counties and 5-7 for equipment. So with the grants of 2018, at the lowest point of the spectrum, 5 years' beneficiaries, the Foundation's aid will benefit around 2,707,590 people in need, well under 1 CHF per person.

2) Food production and water projects have very high numbers of beneficiaries as the whole population of the region benefits whereas school construction, for example, is pricey and only benefits a certain number of children per year.

3) Health centers also have high numbers of beneficiaries as they include the whole population of the area.

4) Most charities defend vociferously that the benefit of a school constructed ought to include the whole population, the families etc as they all benefit. It is true that the whole society benefits, although I preferred to include only the numbers of students attending in 1 year, which in many cases will increase due to the new buildings.
