

Final report to Fondation Eagle

Construction of 3 classrooms at AIC Technical Training Institute,

Naivasha, Kenya

Introduction

In 2019, Fondation Eagle awarded a grant of £18,584 to Footsteps International for the construction of three new classrooms at the AIC Naivasha Technical Training Institute, Naivasha, Kenya.

The project was completed successfully and the classrooms are now in use. During their visit in February 2020, Footsteps trustees visited the completed classrooms and talked to students and staff. The students were extremely pleased with the new facilities, and the staff explained how the new classrooms had made teaching easier, and had enabled them to implement 3 intakes a year which has resulted in increased student recruitment this year.

Once again, the management team and students expressed their thanks for the generosity of Fondation Eagle in making this possible.



On completion of construction, a balance of £1,075 remained unspent from the grant, and Fondation Eagle kindly allowed NTTI to spend this on much-needed tools to assist their vocational courses.
