Notes to the tables:

1) In 2020 Fondation Eagle concentrated on Covid related projects; mainly on feeding, water supplies/installation and health projects

2) Most of the projects funded were for immediate support and aid therefore the actual beneficiaries only relate to the current year. This has resulted in a huge increase in the number of beneficiaries in 2020 totaling at 2,782,112; this works out 0.34 CHF (£ 0.27) per person aided. Unlike former years where most of the projects were grants for construction and purchase of equipment, with benefits continuing over several years. However in the table above only 1 year's beneficiaries were counted for each year; on average we count 7-10 years' use for construction in under-developed countries and 5-7 for equipment.
