Notes to the tables:

- 1) In 2022 Fondation Eagle concentrated on the Food and Water sectors as the need in these sectors has sharply risen, primarily due to the climate change effects. Particularly significant was the drought in East Africa; in these sectors we focused largely on Kenya where the rains had failed for 5 consecutive seasons.

- 2) Please note that most of the projects are funds for construction and purchase of equipment, and thus the beneficiaries will be on-going for several years. In the table above only 1 year's beneficiaries are counted. The norm on average is 7-10 years' use for constructions in under-developed countries and 5-7 years for equipment. So, with the grants of 2022, at the lowest point of the spectrum, 5 years' beneficiaries, the Foundation's aid will benefit around 1,286,815 people in need, well under 1 CHF per person.
